



Acrobat X Professional Advanced

Students will learn how to produce high-quality PDF documents for press. They will learn prepress techniques including color management, proofing and converting colors, color separations, managing inks, trapping, and transparency flattening. Students will use the Preflight feature to test and convert a document to comply with print provider requirements or ISO 9000 standards such as PDF/X, PDF/A, or PDF/E. Students will learn to create, distribute and track interactive forms in both Acrobat and Adobe FormsCentral. They will also learn how to address accessibility issues, use actions to perform multiple tasks at once, and prepare PDF documents for distribution.
